The Foyil Safe School Committee discussed the functions of the Safe School Committee. Reviewed information regarding the All District Safe School Meeting. There were no questions or additions made.

The Threat Risk Assessment was discussed and reviewed. No new areas of risk were identified.

The Committee discussed Bullying issues. The Committee reviewed packets with Bullying Prevention and Reporting Forms for the committee to read and decide if a recommendation of use of these forms should be made to the Foyil School Administration. The Committee will send their decision to Jackie Luckinbill by the end of September. The Committee agreed upon sending out a survey to students to obtain their opinion on where and when bullying is happening. This survey will go out at the beginning of October, 2019. During Red Ribbon Week, bullying will also be addressed in various formats. Presentations to several classes will be commencing through Light of Hope from Claremore, Oklahoma.

The Committee discussed Suicide Prevention and a committee meeting will be scheduled later this fall.

The Committee discussed the topic of Human Trafficking. Forms from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security were handed to each member regarding reporting suspicious activity and the importance of prompt and detailed reporting.

The Committee discussed the need or lack of need for practicing and Evacuation from the school campus. The bus drivers complete a fall and spring evacuation off the school busses. We decided that a practice is not required and that all staff feels comfortable in their roles if such an event should occur.

The Committee checked phone numbers on the contact list to make sure they are correct. Deputy Will Draper, Resource Officer, was added to the list.
